What is the FORTH?

The Specialty Training program

A three year (Full Time) Clinical Post-graduate Specialty Training Program held under the supervision of reputable Supervisors who are MORTH holders.

During the training you will acquire broad clinical experience and knowledge in all aspects of Orthodontics, treatment planning and communication with patients.

Program Details

- 3 years (6 semesters)
- 3 days a week (SATURDAY to MONDAY)
- From 10:00am to 10:00pm

Applicants should:

- Hold a BDS Degree in Dentistry
- Complete their Internship Training
- Pass the first & Second interview held by the RDI
- Pass the Placement exam held by RDI

New Updates

- Starting from September 2026, you will need to Pass MFDS or MJDF part 1&2 to be able to admit for the exam in addition to your 3 years training certificate
- Membership will be fellowship which is higher rank.
- During your training program we offer you an optional preparatory course for mjdf or mfds part 1&2.

Program Overview:

- Starting date: September of each year
- Our center is open 10-10, 6 days/week,48 weeks/year
- 30 days off/year
- The training is for 3 years
- The candidate will have to attend 32 hours/week
- This is divided into:
- 19 hours/week clinical & clinical related activities
- 8 hours/week academic including seminars, Journal clubs, and validated self-study & admin time.
- 5 hours/week research activities

Assessments:

- Written exam after each module.
- Annual written & viva exam in addition to clinical requirements.
- · Passing all assessments is essential to progress in training.

Review meetings:

Each candidate will have quarterly review meeting with his trainer for reflections & feedback.

Absence policy:

90% attendance is compulsory

What are the materials and instruments the center covers?

- We cover some of the consumable material such as brackets, wires, ortho accessories, gloves, napkin Etc.
- All the candidates should get their own instruments such as orthodontic pliers, Low and High-speed contras, diagnostic sets, metal syringes, ortho composite.... Etc.

What certificate do we receive after training?

The aim of MORTH training program is to provide training in theoretical and practical parts. Each candidate receives experience certificate stamped and watermarked by the center, this certificate states that this candidate fulfilled the required training years.

What are the criteria of Training?

The Center follows British guidelines, so we have specific credit hours to be fulfilled during three years, whoever doesn't fulfill these criteria may need to repeat the year failed in or even dismissed from the program.

Who are the instructors?

They are all MORTH holders which is mandatory, to provide real experience related to the same MORTH education.

How can we pay? Can we pay in installments?

Payment is done through cash in center only.

The annual fees are paid through two installments before the start of each FINANCIAL semester.

What are the steps of registration?

- 1. Create account on our website
- 2. Fill the required information and uploading the cv including documented cases if available
- 3. Paying the registration fees (Deducted from the semester fees in case of acceptance, refunded in case of no acceptance)
- 4. Passing first and second interview then the placement test
- 5. Then we will pick the required numbers according to the available seats
